1. Control of match Controls Dead Time on restarts and out of bounds Controls End of Match and issues regarding conduct of the wrestlers		
2. Knowledge of rules Knowledge of the wrestling rules, changes, and interpretations, feeling for the spirit of the rules		
3. Movement and Mat Positioning Moves with the flow of wrestling, in position to see near fall, and make calls, hustles, signal points, illegal holds and potentially dangerous situations		
4. Professionalism and Attitude on the mat Appearance on the mat, poise, professionalism in attitude Observes unbiased relationships with coaches, wrestlers, and spectators. Acts in a courteous and professional manner.		
5. Consistency Consistently awards points when wrestlers gain or lose control Consistently observes relationship of wrestlers from the neutral, down, and out of bounds		
6. Safety/Illegal Holds Protects the safety of both wrestlers (preventive officiating, potentially dangerous holds, out of bounds, verbal cautions)		
7. Signaling Clearly Mechanical aspects of the official demonstrate correct use of signals, proper positioning, and express a relaxed body language		
8. Communications Clearly communicates with the official's table. Clearly communicates to the wrestlers all violations and points earned
